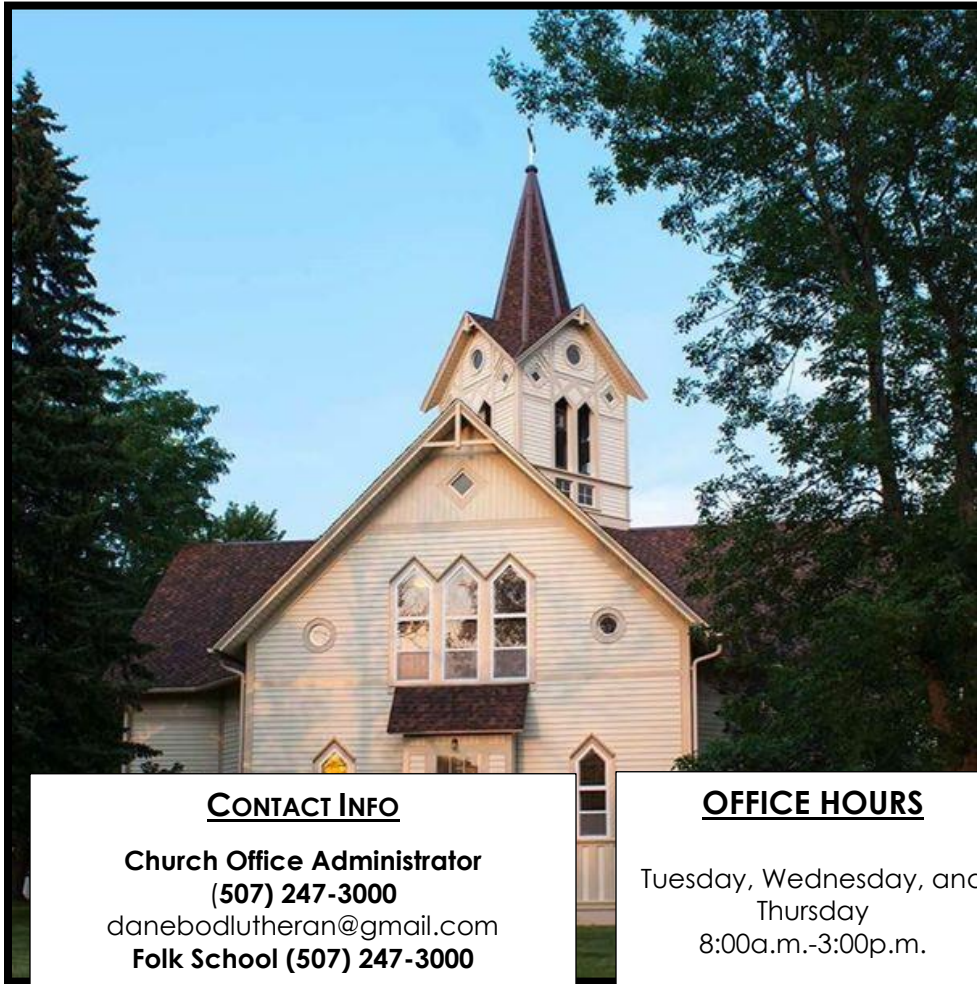

Call Committee Update

The call committee has completed the MSP (Ministry Site Profile) and gone through committee orientation with Pastor Heather from the synod. At this time, we are waiting for the synod to provide us with candidates for us to review. Pastor Heather meets with synod staff weekly to discuss vacancies. Also, we have requested an interim pastor from the synod since Pastor Andrew will be done at the end of August.

Minutes for Danebod Annual Meeting February 6, 2022

Meeting was called to order by Church Council President Jim Johansen at 10:20 AM.

1. **Determination of a Quorum.** A quorum was determined.
2. **Approval of 2021 midyear meeting minutes.** A motion to approve the minutes was made by Laurie Johansen, seconded by Don Buhl, and the motion was carried.
3. **Elections.** The ballot was approved as presented. No other nominations were added. Motion for nominations to cease was made by Larry Wyttenback, seconded by Karen Koster, and the motion was carried.

4. Old Business

A. Approval of the Constitution. Margie Bornhoft spoke about the updates to the constitution. They incorporated all of the continuing bylaws within the constitution instead of having them at the end. A motion to approve was made by Tate Burckhardt, seconded by Joan Jagt, and the motion was carried.

5. New Business

A. Meeting with First English Lutheran Church. Harlan Petersen updated about what has been discussed at three joint church council meetings. We are discussing ways that we can help each other out. Discussed sharing Sunday School, confirmation, having joint services in the summer months, etc. Currently many churches in SW MN synod are without a pastor.

B. Call Committee Update. Ryck Jorgensen discussed the committee's status. Right now the committee is putting together a congregational survey. That will be sent out in February. Once responses are turned in the committee will fill out our ministry site survey for the synod. Then the synod will be able to start looking for candidates that meet our congregational needs.

C. Treasurers Report. Heather Furan reviewed the cash balances, general fund budget and non-budget, memorial fund, actual expenses verses budget, cemetery fund, folk school fund, and folk school budget vs actual. There was a suggestion to list what some of the big purchases were that come out of the undesignated memorial fund in the report.

D. Folk School Committee. Jerry Bly encouraged us to keep maintaining our historical buildings. They will apply for a grant for a structural assessment of the building. This will determine if the structure can support a fire suppressant system. They invested in bat removal repairs to the roof. The folk school is open for activities this year. There are family camps in June, July, and August. There will be the annual folk meeting in August. They are still looking for a head cook for the entire summer.

E. Financial Advisory Committee. Tate Burckhardt summarized the report from this past year. He went over the proposed distributions for the Eklund Fund and answered a few questions. He reviewed the cemetery fund, the church foundation fund, and the folk school foundation fund. A motion was made to approve the distribution by Larry Wyttenback, seconded by Jerry Bly, and the motion was carried.

F. Danebod Village. Glen Petersen spoke about the Danebod Village. Glen thanked the staff and board of the village. He thanked Harlan Petersen and Dale Schak for doing some bathroom remodeling projects. The 1918 building was torn down, one of the building was shingled, and several other projects were complete.

G. Cemetery. No presentation.

H. Piano for the church. Curt Madsen spoke about the current piano in the upstairs of the church. The piano will not stay in tune. They are raising funds to purchase a new piano. They are looking for pledges.

I. Adoption of 2022 Budgets. All in attendance had the opportunity to look through the proposed budget and ask questions. A motion to approve the folk school budget was made by Deb Burckhardt, and seconded by Diane Clark, and the motion was carried. A motion to approve the church council budget was made by Jerry Bly, and seconded by Ryck Jorgensen, and the motion was carried.

J. Election Results. Erik Jorgensen, Lena Burckhardt, and Harlan Petersen were elected to church council. Mark Stage, Olga Ekberg, and Tate Burckhardt were elected to 3 year term, Joann Peterson was elected to a 2 year term. All other committees elected all that were listed on the ballot.

6. Adjourn. A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Craig Hess, seconded by Carol Ekberg, the motion past and the meeting was adjourned at 11:20 AM.
