## Minutes for Danebod Church Council June 14, 2022

**PRESENT:** Jim Johansen (President), Harlan Petersen (VP), Lena Burckhardt (Secretary), Joy Schak, Natalie Jerzak, Joan Jagt, Carol Ekberg, Jarod Hansen, Erik Jorgensen, Heather Furan (Treasurer).

**NOT PRESENT:**,

At 7:03 PM the meeting was called to order by Jim Johansen and a quorum was established. No additions were made to the agenda.

### **REPORTS:**

1. Secretary's report for May was presented. MSC to approve May minutes made by Harlan and seconded by Carol.
2. Treasurer's report for May was presented. MSC to approve May report made by Joan and seconded by Harlan.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Call Committee update – MSC to add Paul Ekema to the call committee by Joan and seconded by Natalie. The call committee interviewed a candidate from Denmark. The candidate decided to not continue on with the interview process. The call committee met with Pastor Heather from the synod for an orientation session on the process of calling a pastor.
2. Parsonage project update – The bathroom shower still needs to be installed. Hoping to get the project done by the end of the summer.
3. Bishop Dee Review – The council and the call committee met with the Bishop after church on May 15<sup>th</sup>. She came very prepared to discuss the call process and our potential Danish candidate.
4. Elevator update – A zoom meeting was held with the structural engineers who are assessing the building to see if it's strong enough to support a fire suppression system.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Trees – Several trees south of the parsonage are rotten and need to be removed. MSC to have Lamote Tree Service do an assessment of the trees and remove whatever is necessary was made by Joan and seconded by Harlan.
2. Pulpit supply – In July we will have Pastor Danner on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. Pastor Andrew will be leading church on the 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>.
3. Funerals & Weddings - MSC to pay \$250 for pulpit supply plus milage to cover funerals and weddings made by Natalie and seconded by Erik.
4. Joint Church Council Meeting – There will be a joint meeting of the Danebod and First English church councils at 6:30 on July 17<sup>th</sup>.

### **Committee Reports**

Administration (Joan Jagt, Erik Jorgensen, and Harlan Petersen) – discussed the pastor's job description, the committee will review and update it

Property (Jarod Hansen) – Got a couple of bids for replacing the deck at the parsonage. MSC to proceed with the construction of a composite deck on the parsonage for the quoted amount of \$17,000 made by Harlan and seconded by Joan.

Cemetery (Jim Johansen) – Fixed the brick pillar by the entrance.

Parish Education & Youth Ministry (Lena Burckhardt) – no report

Outreach & Stewardship (Natalie Jerzak) – If anyone knows of a family going through a hard time please let Natalie know and the committee could bring them a meal or find some other way to support them. 3-day camp went well. There were 58 kids including the counselors. They were really well-behaved campers. The kids danced and sang for residents of the nursing home.

Worship & Music (Carol Ekberg) – no report

Folk School (Joy Schak) – June family camp starts next week. Right now they still don't have a head cook. There are some church members who have volunteered to help out with the cooking for the June camp. The committee is going to paint the pavilion sometime this summer.

Financial Advisory (Harlan Petersen) – no report

Meeting was called to order by President Glen. No additions were made to the agenda.

Motion made by Connie to approve the minutes of the April meeting, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Larry, approved.

Darla gave the financial report. There was an additional area of pavement done in the lot. We were charged a service charge of \$20 per building on the city bill because it was late due to questions on the bill. Darla will talk to the city office. Motion made by Bev to accept the report, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jeanne, approved.

### OLD BUSINESS

- a. Our tenant from #407 has been relocated to assisted living for a while. A family member is asking for an extension on her rental until the end of June. Motion made by Connie to give this extension, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jeanne, approved.

Some issues have already been noticed. They are replacing a cracked toilet, trimming a tree, putting on gutters, and a ceiling tile in a basement apartment.

We now have a new owner at the Tyler Bank. Lee made a motion for the officers and Darla to get signed up and authorized with the new company; to access and utilize on-line banking at 1st Independent Bank, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Larry, approved.

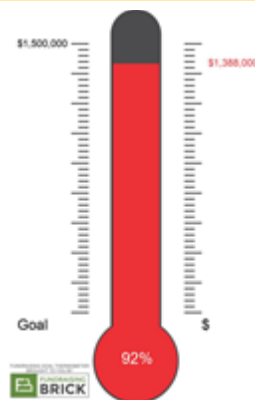
